- Soundboard of choice Sitka spruce, precisely graduated for maximum acoustic response.
- Five-piece laminated neck, of Honduras mahogany and rock maple, reinforced internally by a fully adjustable metal tension rod
- Flared, veneered peghead finished with dark walnut.
- Top quality ebony fingerboard.
- Nickel silver frets, precision honed to .001" tolerance.
- Genuine mother-of-pearl inlays.
- Bridge of ebony-stained Brazilian rosewood.
- Bonding with aircraft-type adhesives, stronger than the components they join.
- Hand-rubbed polyester finish, beautiful and highly flexible, yet exceptionally durable.
